

Updated information for members and visitors following the recent relaxation of restrictions by the government.

Information prepared on 29th July 2021 following a review of the church risk assessment on 27.07.21

Please refer to the updated risk assessment displayed on the notice board, provided to members via e mail and posted on the church website.

Here are the main changes...

- We are retaining the one way system. Follow the arrows in the entrance hall.
- Please continue to use the hand sanitiser.
- Track and trace records will still be kept.
- The limit on visitors is now 50.
- The seats are now back in rows in most of the church. There are more seats available than required so that you can spread out and maintain social distancing if you wish. Anyone who wishes to sit away from anyone else should use the seats placed around tables at the rear of church or the seats at the back and sides of church.
- Seat names have been removed. You can sit where you like but please choose one seat and stick to it for each visit.
- Hymn books have been placed on seats. Please do not share the hymn books or pass them to anyone else. Leave the hymn book on your seat when you leave. Books will not be touched for 7 days.
- Doors will continue to be propped open to allow ventilation.
- There are limited children's toys and books available. Parents please supervise.
- Masks are optional.
- Singing is allowed.
- From 8th August tea, coffee and biscuits will be served after the service. Please stay in your seat. We will bring refreshments to you. There will be no access to the kitchen.
